2008 HUDSON VINEYARD
Carneros Chardonnay

Hudson Vineyard is located in a cool section of Carneros. The unique location of Hudson Vineyard allows the grapes longer hangtime to develop flavor and intensity, without sacrificing acidity and balance.

Exuberant aromas of pineapple, peach and pear.

Sophisticated layers of poached pear, spice cake, caramel apple ginger and clove.

Creamy mouthcoating texture.
